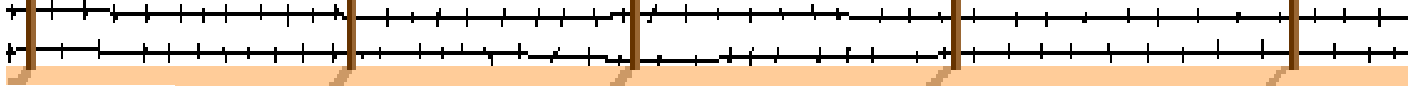

INDIVIDUAL DRIVEWAYS OR PADS

This will include sweeping the area to be done and chip and seal applied. This will be identical rock and seal as is used in the park. FLEA MARKET PORCH SALES NOVEMBER 4TH

If you need the item picked up from your lot someone will do that from 9:00 > 10:00 AM on November 3rd. Leave them by the curb.

All items must be tagged with your name, lot #, price you want, and minimum price you will accept. Remember that 10% of the sale price goes to the Bluebonnets. DO NOT leave items on the porch when no one is there to accept them. If something is left there with no ID it will be sold for "best offer" and all \$ will go to Bluebonnets.
