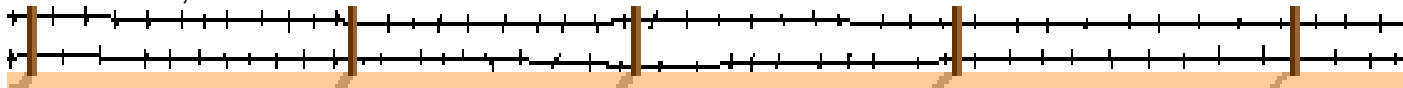

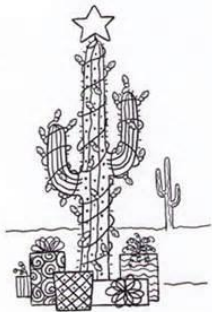
### **THE FIDDLERS WILL BE IN THE CLUBHOUSE ON SATURDAY, DECEMBER 9, 2016**
