NO MORE STUMBLING AROUND IN THE DARK!!

The Maintenance and Construction Committee has replaced the non-functioning or missing outside lights over the Clubhouse doorways so we won't have anyone stumbling around in the dark anymore. The new motion-activated lights are set to come on at low brightness at dusk and remain on for six hours. Upon sensing someone moving in the area at any time of the night, a light will go to full brightness and remain there for five minutes after the last movement is sensed before dropping back to low or off. When fully bright, they draw 32 watts per fixture (the old fixtures would draw up to 300 watts), and on low they draw less than half that. The new fixtures are mounted higher than previously so that the porch roofs will block glare into nearby members' lots. Please leave the switch next to each door in the "on" position.
