DUMP RUN - Starting at 8 a.m. Please have your "dump" items on your curb before 8 a.m., Saturday. You can also put them out on the front of your lot Friday evening. If you want to help pick up stuff, meet at the maintenance shed at 8 a.m. on Saturday.

WHAT IS A "DUMP RUN"?

A Dump Run is a way for LSC members to get rid of "stuff" like scrap wood, broken furniture, appliances, etc. Someone volunteers to pull the Park Trailer up and down all the roads in the park. There is someone who checks off the sites that have "stuff" to be picked up. Several people volunteer to walk alongside of the trailer and load the "stuff" onto it. Then the "stuff" is taken to the Dump in Hondo. The Park pays for the "stuff" to be dumped. Each lot that has "stuff" will receive their share of the charge for dumping, in their electric bill. This is calculated by the Total Dump charge divided by the number of lots that had "stuff".
