SPRING CLEANUP ON SATURDAY, MARCH 3, 2018!!!



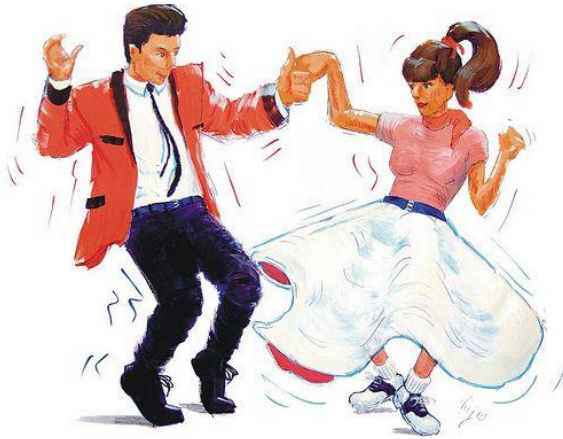
I hope you all have reserved this Saturday, March 3, to help with spring cleanup.

Crape Myrtles need pruning where branches cross and rub creating scars and stressing the trees. Air plants need to be removed from trees before the leaves hide them. Cut back to the ground the 2 purple sage in front at either side of the star. Adopted spots are planning their own clean up. The common areas that are not adopted also need to be cleaned up. 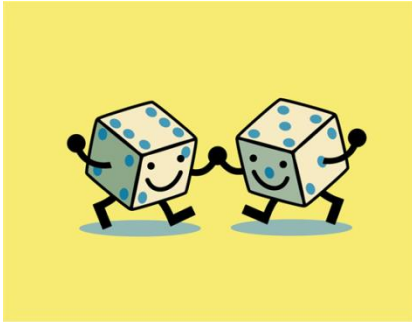
