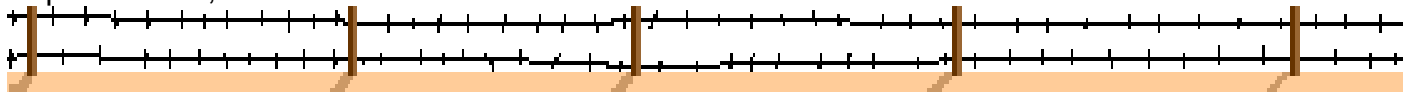

### **ROAD WORK PROJECT**

The road work will be starting the week of Sept 25, 2017. This will be in progress for 6-9 weeks as determined by the weather. Large equipment will be in and about the park. Be prepared to be inconvenienced at times. We will notify members the day ahead of their street being worked on. Plan ahead so as to not have to leave except for doctors' appointments or an emergency situation for the duration of your street work. ### **INDIVIDUAL DRIVEWAYS OR PADS**

While our park roads are being done Chester(MGMC) has offered to do driveway or pads. At a cost of .25 per square foot, and each individual is responsible for payment. This will include sweeping the area to be done and chip and seal applied. This will be identical rock and seal as is used in the park. ## LANDSCAPE NEWS

Landscaping in Lone Star Corral is looking good despite the summer heat. There always seems to be something green or colorful in the common areas or individual lots. It is apparent that members take pride in our park, and will continue throughout the coming fall and winter months.

We have a landscape committee that is tasked with overseeing the common areas, surrounding the clubhouse and at the ends of each street. Individual members have adopted areas to personally care for, and there are more areas ready to be adopted by other members.

If you have a favorite spot that you would like to tend during the time you are in the park, please let someone on the Committee know. We are planning a meeting sometime in October for everyone who is interested in landscaping.

In the meantime, now is the time to plant if you want fall vegetables. All kinds of greens do well here in the fall and winter. You may have to cover them for protection during a couple of freezes during the winter, or if planted in pots, just move them inside your shed for a night or two. Also, now is the time to plant wildflower seeds, especially bluebonnets and poppies. These will grow strong roots during the winter, and bloom for you in the early springtime. The only exception is please plant new trees in pots only, not directly in the ground. Shrubs are fine, but tree roots may damage our existing underground pipe system.
